The adventure begins with a scenic chairlift ride to the top of Howelsen Hill, where riders board individual sleds for a thrilling descent down a twisting, turning track. Using the Barrows chairlift at Howelsen Hill, we also provide scenic chairlift rides and mountain bike transport for bike trails on Emerald Mountain. While proceeds from the Howler benefit the athletes of SSWSC, its greatest impact may be the opportunity it provides as a first-time summer job experience for local teenagers.

JOB RESPONSIBILITIES:

The slide manager is responsible for hiring, staffing, and training employees. Managing all aspects of staff scheduling and payroll and staff incentive plans to ensure adequate staffing coverage each day. The manager is responsible for the daily operation and safety of the alpine slide and Barrows scenic chairlift ride, with a focus on staff performance, rider safety and providing a quality guest experience. Ensuring compliance with all safety protocols of chairlift and slide operation and associated record keeping is crucial. Computer experience is important for learning the point of sales system and scheduling software.
