Desired Skills and Abilities

- Must have First Aid training and be able to administer if needed.
- Must complete SafeSport Training and Head's Up Concussion Training yearly.
- Must complete background screening every 2 years.
- Strong team player, good sense of humor and ability to keep focus of job in perspective.
- Must enjoy working in and around young athletes and be responsible for their safety and well-being.
- Must possess excellent relationship and communication skills, in order to work closely with other coaches/parents/athletes and community partners.

Physical Requirements

- Must be able to ride a bicycle for 2-4 hours at a slow or fast pace.
- Must have good bike handling skills.
- Must coach on mountain bike with hand brakes and gears.

Specific Duties and Responsibilities

- Primary focus is to coach a developmental cycling program.
- Work with head coach to create and implement specific training plans for coaches to teach for each session.
- Communicate effectively and positively with kids and their parents.
- Be patient, caring and supportive of each athlete.
- Uphold and contribute to the SSWSC mission, vision and core values.
- Collaborate with other Cycling Coaches and/or Cycling Director regarding goal for each session.
- Maintain a positive relationship with RCR, USFS, City of Steamboat Springs, SSRC.
- Must be on time (15 minutes before meeting time.)
- Assist in cycling events organized by SSWSC - Bike Swap and Bike Rodeos
- Demonstrate and teach proper road riding etiquette, stopping at stop signs/traffic lights, following street smart rules.
- Demonstrate and teach proper trail etiquette, yielding to uphill traffic, not riding on wet trails, heeding to closed signs.
