- Tap Buddy's statue with your ski pole at the top of Storm Peak for good luck!
- Hike up to North St. Pats or ski straight down Christmas Tree Bowl for a double diamond challenge.
- Relax on the lounge chairs outside of Four Points Lodge.
- Ski down Nelson's Run, a bump run with an excellent pitch named after Steamboat Freestyle Olympian Nelson Carmichael.
