EVENTS: March 3 - Non-elimination Parallel Panel SL followed by Nat'l Team duals

March 4 – GS (National point scored event) March 5 – SL (National point scored event)

LOCATION: March 3 & 5 races at Howelsen Hill, March 4 race at Steamboat Ski Resort

ELIGIBILITY: Any Rocky Mountain Division or Central Division U14 or U16 alpine competitor member who

does not qualify to race in the Rocky/Central U14 or U16 Championships events.

PARALLEL SLALOM INFO: Races will be held in the afternoon and evening at Howelsen Hill. Lift load is at noon. In the afternoon, racers will compete individually in a non-elimination parallel. This race includes two heats where racers compete in two runs per heat and all four runs count, no skier is eliminated. In the second heat, racers race next to the skier that was closest to them from the first heat. All racers will also be placed on a national team with racers from around the Rocky/Central Region. In the evening under the lights, these national teams will race duals, with each team member scoring points for their nation to try to advance to the

the athletes.

ENTRY FEE: \$160, includes all race day activities including the BBQ on March 3, and welcome gift.
